The Craig PTSA will be awarding one scholarship to the 2024 graduating class. The scholarship awarded will be in the amount of \$500.00. The scholarship may be used at a college, university, trade school, or to support students attending a military academy. The scholarship will be paid during the student's second semester of school, after receiving a transcript showing satisfactory achievement (a minimum 2.5 GPA) during their first semester.

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS APRIL 30, 2024

All eligible application packets will be reviewed and graded by the PTSA board at their monthly meeting in May. The scholarship recipient will be notified via email no later than May 20, 2024 after the board has made their decision.

It is the winner's responsibility to provide an official transcript of their fall 2024 semester to the PTSA by email before a check will be issued. The scholarship check will be sent directly to the school listed on the scholarship application. If the recipient is an individual attending a military academy, the funds may be sent directly to the recipient. Any changes to the school name or address should be included with the transcript information in order for the check to get to the correct location. Transcript and any further information should be sent to the Craig PTSA email listed above to receive the check.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Please submit the following as one complete, typed packet:

1. Cover Page – must show applicant's name, email, mailing address, phone number, college name, and financial aid mailing address if applicable (10 points for neatness/completeness of application)
2. Essay – 200-400 words that discuss applicant's plans for further education and goals in life (30 points)
3. Transcript – showing seven semesters of grades with a 2.5 GPA or above (20 points)
4. Volunteer Time (10 points)– a list of school and community volunteer activities. To be included in this list are the:
 - a) Activity b) Date of Activity c) Number of Hours Worked d) Adult Signature Verification.*Additional 10 points given to those who have volunteer time on the PTSA board and/or events.
5. Resume (10 points)
6. Two Letters of Recommendation – one must be from a school staff member and one must be from a community member not related to you (10 points)

Application packets are to be postmarked by April 30th or delivered to the PTSA box at CES no later than 4pm on that day to be considered.
